





The Fairport Harbor Marine Museum is the first Great Lakes Lighthouse Marine Museum in the State of Ohio as well as the United States. The Museum was founded in 1945 by the Fairport Harbor Historical Society and is devoted to preserving and perpetuating historic tradition and sentiment in Fairport Harbor and the Great Lakes Area.





· The Grand River ·

Follow the Grand River from Lake Erie to the Grand River Valley and Beyond!

The 102-mile Grand River begins in Geauga County, flows east through Trumbull County, and then turns north into Ashtabula County before meandering west toward Lake Erie. Its final 10 miles pass through Painesville, Fairport Harbor, and the village of Grand River, with its mouth at Fairport Harbor. The 712-square-mile Grand River Watershed spans parts of Ashtabula, Geauga, Lake, Portage, and Trumbull counties.

Mentor Marsh, a National Natural Landmark and former Grand River channel, lies west of the river's current mouth. Erosion created a new outlet, leaving the 673-acre Mentor Marsh State Nature Preserve as one of

Lake Erie's largest natural marshes.

The Grand River Valley, designated as an American Viticultural Area, is renowned for grape growing thanks to its favorable micro-climate, extended growing season, and well-drained slopes. In Ashtabula County, three historic covered bridges span the river, including the Harpersfield Bridge, Ohio's second longest, and the Mechanicsville Road Bridge, its oldest.

Designated as a State Scenic and Wild River, the Grand River is popular for steelhead and muskellunge fishing, making it a prized natural resource in Ohio.




Just Across the River!
